21 SEPTEMBER 2021 AT 18.30

Purpose of the meeting: Consultation with residents about proposals for a Quiet Lanes application for Rogues Lane and Walnuts Lane.

1. James Clarke presented the background to the public meeting which followed a drop to residents of approx 140 leaflets introducing the Quiet Lane concept. In response to questions, it was stated that the cost to the Parish council would be £50. There is no legal enforcement to prevent cars or other vehicles using the lanes or being subject to a speed limit. The aim of the Quiet Lane notices is to be a visual reminder that the roads are shared by all. Wickham Market PC has no objection to the part of Walnuts Lane that is in its parish being a Quiet Lane. It was stated that although Campsea Ashe Parish Council wishes to designate Loudham Hall Road as a Quiet Lane, Pettistree P.C. is not in favour. This objection is due to the narrow width, poor visibility and absence, for a large section east of the entrance to Loudham Hall, of any verge or means of escape from the carriageway for pedestrians and other users.
2. Jeff Hallett took the opportunity to update those present about the SID provision and James Clarke elaborated on their use. It was stressed that villagers should be discouraged from 'testing' the units as it only flashes when the speed is within 10% of the speed limit, but all movements are recorded.
3. The Solar Park proposal for Loudham was also briefly described and people encouraged to view the planning application once it is published.

- The request for suitable names for the 5 roads on the Hopkins Homes development was discussed and it was thought that names associated with the original field names in that area would be appropriate. The Parish Council will confer by e-mail or telephone to finalise suggested names.

- Further discussion of possible street names for the new Hopkins development took place with old field names taken from the Tithe Map. These were: Observers, Barrows, Robin Close, Damsons & Ethelwold.
- Jeff thanked those present for their time and in particular thanked James Clarke for his efforts in ensuring the Quiet Lane proposal could be progressed and his work with the SID.
